

FEEDER STEER SHOW FRIDAY, JAN. 27, 2017, 11:30 A.M.

- Only 2016 Feeder Steers are eligible. No weight limits.
- Feeder steers may be entered in either a **BREED** division or **CROSSBRED** division. Classes within the respective division will be divided by hip height and weight if needed. Steers must be left free-standing in the chute while being measured.
- A feeder steer may be entered in only one (1) division, as designated by the entry form. All steers showing by breed must be sired by a registered bull of that particular breed. Steers will be classified by breed with uniform class breaks by hip height. Breeds to include: Angus, Charolais, Composite Charolais, Chianina, Chi Influence, Gelbvieh, Hereford, Limousin, Lim-flex, Maine Anjou, Maintainer, Red Angus, Shorthorn, Shorthorn Plus, Simmental, Foundation Simmental and Commercial. No minimum number of entries required — a show is guaranteed for each breed. Show is alphabetical by breed. **REGISTRATION PAPERS ARE REQUIRED FOR EACH BREED.** If there are no registration papers, the animal will show as Crossbred.
- **Arrival time is no later than 5 p.m. Thursday, Jan. 26, 2017. All steers will be measured and tagged between 2-5 p.m. on Thursday, Jan. 26, 2017. CVIs must be given to Farm Show Personnel at this time.**
- The top 10 steers of the show will be selected after all classes are placed. Grand and Reserve Champions and the next eight (8) steers will be placed. Trophies will be awarded to overall Grand and Reserve Champions. **The Grand Champion overall will receive \$500 and the Reserve Champion overall will receive \$300; 3rd place: \$150, 4th place: \$100, 5th place: \$75, 6th place: \$50, 7th place: \$40, 8th place: \$35, 9th place: \$30, 10th place: \$20.**
- Fifteen dollars (\$15) of the entry fee in each class will be prorated back as prize money as follows: 1st place: 40 percent, 2nd place: 20 percent, 3rd-6th places: 10 percent each. Class winners will receive \$25 guarantee for first place, \$15 for second place or the percentage, whichever is greater. The Sioux Empire Farm Show will make provisions for \$50 and \$25 cash awards to each breed champion and reserve champion, respectively.
- Early entry fee is \$35/online or \$45/mailed per individual entry. Late entries must pay \$55 per individual entry. Early entries must be postmarked by Jan. 6, 2017. Early online entries will be accepted through Jan. 13, 2017. **NO REFUNDS. NO SUBSTITUTIONS.**

OPEN BREEDING BEEF HEIFER SHOW SATURDAY, JAN. 28, 2017, 12:30 P.M.

- All 2016 Heifers and Fall 2015 Heifers are eligible.
- Heifers may be entered in either a **BREED** division or **COMMERCIAL** division. Classes for breeds will be divided by age; the crossbred division will show by hip height. Breed representatives will verify breed and their decisions will be final.
- A heifer may be entered in only one division. Designate division on entry form. Breeds to include: Angus, Charolais, Charolais Composite, Chianina, Chi Influence, Gelbvieh, Hereford, Limousin, Lim-flex, Maine Anjou, Maintainer, Red Angus, Shorthorn, Shorthorn Plus, Simmental, Simmental Percentage and Commercial. No minimum number of entries required — a show is guaranteed for each breed. Show is alphabetical by breed. **HEIFERS ENTERED IN BREED CLASSES MUST BE TATTOOED AND MUST HAVE REGISTRATION PAPERS OR A WAIVER FROM THE BREED ASSOCIATION MUST BE IN-HAND STATING THAT REGISTRATION PAPERS HAVE BEEN APPLIED FOR. Registration papers are REQUIRED FOR EACH BREED.** If there are no registration papers, the animal will show as Commercial.
- **Deadline for arrival is 8:30 a.m. on Saturday, Jan. 28, 2017. CHECK-IN TIME IS 11-5 P.M. ON THURSDAY, JAN. 26, 2017 AND 6:30-9 A.M. ON SATURDAY, JAN. 28, 2017. EAR TAGS WILL BE ASSIGNED FOR EACH ANIMAL AT TIME OF CHECK-IN. HEALTH PAPERS MUST BE GIVEN TO FARM SHOW PERSONNEL AT THIS TIME.**
- First and second place in each class will compete for Division Champion and Reserve Division Champion. Division and Reserve Division Champions will show for overall Grand and Reserve Champions.
- Fifteen (15) dollars of the entry fee will be prorated back as prize money as follows: 1st: 40 percent, 2nd: 20 percent, 3rd-6th: 10 percent each. Class winners will receive \$25 guarantee for first place, \$15 for second place or the percentage, whichever is greater. The Sioux Empire Farm Show will make provisions for \$50 and \$25 cash awards to each breed champion and reserve champion, respectively. The top 10 heifers of the show will be selected after all classes are placed. Grand and Reserve and the next eight (8) heifers will be placed. **The Grand Champion overall will receive \$500, Reserve Champion overall will receive \$300; 3rd place: \$150, 4th place: \$100, 5th place: \$75, 6th place: \$50, 7th place: \$40, 8th place: \$35, 9th place: \$30, 10th place: \$20.** Trophies will be awarded to overall Grand and Reserve Champions.
- Early entry fee is \$35/online or \$45/mailed per individual entry. Late entries must pay \$55/individual entry. Early entries must be postmarked by Jan. 6, 2017. Early online entries will be accepted through Jan. 13, 2017. **NO REFUNDS. NO SUBSTITUTIONS.**

2017 CATTLE SHOW GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

- **Bring only the animals entered. No substitutes.**
- Entries must be halter broke.
- Ear tags will be assigned for each animal at time of weigh/measure.
- Early entries must be postmarked by Jan. 6, 2017. Early online entries will be accepted through Jan. 13, 2017. Entry fees must accompany entry forms. No refunds. After Jan. 6, 2017, mailed entries are LATE entries.
- All decisions of the Farm Show Personnel and Judge will be final.
- Cash awards and payments will be mailed to winners within 30 days of the conclusion of the Sioux Empire Farm Show.
- **All animals must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI).** One certificate per consignor is acceptable; however, do not put breeding heifers, feeder heifers, feeder steers and market beef on the same certificate. Official ID is required to be listed on health certificate. **Out of state animals must have a permit number to enter South Dakota and the Sioux Empire Farm Show. Call the State Veterinarian at (605) 773-3321 to obtain a permit number on the CVI.** The animal(s) must meet tuberculosis and brucellosis qualifications of South Dakota and must be free of any infectious, contagious or communicable disease such as ringworms, warts, pinkeye or lumpy jaw. If warts have been surgically removed, the scars must be healed by the time of exhibition. **Before unloading, CVIs must be shown to a livestock attendant in the blue information shack.** The original will be collected at show check-in.
- One fitting chute will be allowed per three animals at a cost of \$30 per chute; a second chute is only allowed in with the fourth head at an additional cost of \$30. Upon check-in, chute tags will be issued and must be attached to the fitting chute(s) or chute(s) will be removed from the building.
- No generators are allowed INSIDE the Expo Building. It will be necessary for anyone grooming animals to bring their own 12-gauge, 100'-200' extension cords.
- No dogs are allowed in the Expo Building during the Sioux Empire Farm Show.
- **Display pens for stalling are available at \$75 per head per day.** A separate letter requesting this space is required.
- Please send a copy of breed registration papers with entry.
- No unethical oral or injected altering material will be allowed on any animal at the Sioux Empire Farm Show. The Farm Show retains the right to sample/test if needed.

UNLOADING IS ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE EXPO BUILDING ONLY. PARKING IS IN THE SOUTH LOT, WHICH IS SOUTH OF THE FAIRGROUNDS FENCE. DO NOT TIE CATTLE TO THE CHAINLINK FENCE.

FEEDER HEIFER SHOW THURSDAY, JAN. 26, 2017 • 6 P.M.

- Only 2016 Feeder Heifers are eligible. NO WEIGHT LIMITS.
- Feeder heifers may be entered in either **ENGLISH** division or **CROSSBRED** division.
- Classes within the respective division will be divided by weight and hip height. Heifers must be left free-standing in the chute while being measured and weighed.
- **Arrival time is no later than 11 a.m. on Thursday, Jan. 26, 2017. Feeder heifers will be measured and tagged between 11 a.m.-1 p.m. on Thursday, Jan. 26, 2017. Health papers must be given to Farm Show Personnel at this time.**
- Feeder heifers may also show in the Breeding Beef Show on Saturday, Jan. 28, 2017, provided the entry fee for the Breeding Beef Heifer Show has been paid.
- Grand Champion overall will receive a cash award of \$200. Reserve Champion overall will receive a \$100 cash award.
- Fifteen dollars (\$15) of the entry fee in each class will be prorated back as prize money as follows: 1st: 40 percent, 2nd: 20 percent, 3rd-6th: 10 percent each. Class winners will receive \$25 guarantee for first place, \$15 for second place or the percentage, whichever is greater.
- Early entry fee is \$35/online or \$45/mailed per individual heifer. Late entries must pay \$55 per individual heifer. Early entries must be postmarked by Jan. 6, 2017. Early online entries will be accepted through Jan. 13, 2017. NO REFUNDS. NO SUBSTITUTIONS.

OPEN CLASS MARKET BEEF SHOW & SALE FRIDAY, JAN. 27, 2017, 10:30 A.M.

- All market steers and heifers will be weighed, measured at the hip then divided into classes. Ear tags will be assigned for each animal at time of weigh/measure.
- **Arrival time is anytime after 8 a.m. on Thursday, Jan. 26, 2017. Deadline for arrival is 3 p.m. Thursday, Jan. 26, 2017. WEIGH-IN TIME IS FROM 1-3 P.M. THURSDAY, JAN. 26, 2017. Re-weighs are at the discretion of Farm Show Personnel.**
- COOL forms must be completed and signed at check-in
- The top four animals in each division will be placed by the judge. The first and second place in each class will compete for Grand and Reserve Champion. The Grand and Reserve Champions and additional three (3) animals, as determined at the discretion of Farm Show Personnel, will be sold at the Mayor's Round-Up & Sale of Champions on Friday, Jan. 27, 2017 at the Best Western PLUS Ramkota Exhibit Hall in Sioux Falls.
- **SALE OF CHAMPIONS:** All Sale of Champions animals will be terminated. All market animals held for the Sale of Champions MUST be stalled in a designated area in the Expo Building until transport to the Sale of Champions on Friday: they may not leave for any reason. **Transport of Market Beef cattle to the Exhibit Hall and back is the responsibility of the consignor.** After the sale, all animals must be tied with adequate halters. The Sale of Champions is a terminal sale. **Premium checks for those animals held for the Sale of Champions will be mailed within 30 days. Animals must be present at the sale in order to receive your check.**
- Any or all market steers weighing 1,475 lbs. or more will not be eligible for the Sale of Champions or terminal markets.
- Ten (\$10) dollars of entry fee will be prorated in the form of premiums. **The top four animals in each class will receive cash awards according to their placing: 1st: 40 percent, 2nd: 30 percent, 3rd: 20 percent, 4th: 10 percent. The Grand Champion will receive \$500 cash award; the Reserve Champion will receive a \$250 cash award.**
- Early entry fee is \$45/online or \$55/mailed per individual entry. Late entries must pay \$65 per individual entry. Early entries must be postmarked by Jan. 6, 2017. Early online entries will be accepted through Jan. 13, 2017. NO REFUNDS. NO SUBSTITUTIONS.
