## 2018 MARKET GOAT SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

- Entries made in this department shall be subject to and each exhibitor agrees to abide by the following; Sioux Empire Farm Show personnel reserve the right to adjust Rules and Regulations as seen fit.
- All goats must have individual SCRAPIES ID tag along with herd ID number, which should match the tag number on Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI).
- CVI must contain identification as to breed, sex, ear tag number and owner's name and address.
- CVIs must be properly made out and issued within 30 days of the opening of the show.
- **ALL OUT OF STATE GOATS NEED A PERMIT NUMBER TO ENTER SOUTH DAKOTA.** Please have your veterinarian call the South Dakota State Veterinarian office for the PERMIT NUMBER at (605) 773-3321.
- Any goat that is not accompanied by a CVI or does not comply with any of the above regulations will not be admitted to the Sioux Empire Farm Show. Goats must be free of scabies, scrapies and any other symptoms of disease. The health certificate MUST STATE goats are free of signs of scabies, scrapies and fungus.
- Prior to unloading, you must show the CVI to the livestock attendant. CVI's will be collected at check-in.
- Goats eligible to show are does and castrated males. Goats must be under the age of one year and have milk/kid teeth in place. Goats whose teeth have been tampered with will be disqualified at the discretion of show officials.
- Online entry fee is \$20/head; mailed entry fee is \$25/head; late entries must pay \$40/head. Early entries must be postmarked by Jan. 5, 2018, and online entries will be accepted through Jan. 12, 2018. No refunds will be issued.
- Arrival time is any time after 8:30 p.m. on Thursday, Jan. 25, 2018. Weigh-in of all goats is scheduled from 8-9 a.m. on Friday, Jan. 26, 2018. There is a minimum weight of 50 pounds. Goats will be ear-tagged. **See "NEW TO SEFS" verbiage for weigh back system being implemented in 2018.**
- COOL forms must be completed and signed at check-in. Goats must be broke to lead and must be shown with collars and leashes and/or halters. No spike chains will be allowed. Muzzles will be allowed.
- No unethical oral or injected altering material will be allowed on any animal at the Sioux Empire Farm Show. The Farm Show retains the right to sample/test if needed.
- If horned, market goats must have horns rounded off.
- Goats must be uniformly slick shorn with 3/8 inch of hair or less above the knee and hock joints to include the head excluding the tail prior to check-in.
- Exhibitors will not be permitted to lift the front legs of goats off the ground during judging. Any exhibitor not abiding by this rule will be disqualified.
- Exhibitors are responsible for keeping stalls clean and will provide their own feed and water. A layer of bedding will be provided with additional bedding available for purchase.
- A \$250 cash award for Champion Market Goat will be awarded and \$150 for the Reserve Champion Market Goat. The Grand and Reserve Champions and an additional three (3) animals, as determined at the discretion of Farm Show Personnel, will be sold at the Mayor's Round-Up & Sale of Champions Friday, Jan. 26, 2018 at the Best Western PLUS Ramkota Exhibit Hall in Sioux Falls.
- **SALE OF CHAMPIONS:** All Sale of Champions animals will be terminated. All market animals held for the Sale of Champions MUST be stalled in a designated area in the Expo Building until transport to the Sale of Champions on Friday — they may not leave for any reason. Goats, swine and sheep will be transported by Farm Show Personnel. After the sale, all animals must be tied with adequate halters. The Sale of Champions is a terminal sale. **Premium checks for those animals held for the Sale of Champions will be mailed within 30 days. Animals must be present at the sale in order to receive your check.**
- All Sale of Champions Market Goats will be processed for collection of carcass data.
- Cash awards will be mailed to winners within 30 days of the conclusion of the Sioux Empire Farm Show.
- **NEW TO SEFS:** This year the Sioux Empire Farm Show will be using a weigh back system for the Market Swine Show, Market Lamb Show, and Market Goat Show. All hogs, goats, and lambs will show under a declared weight through submission of a weight card. Exhibitors are responsible for weighing their own animals, whether at home or on the check scale at the Show and then declaring that weight on the cards. Exhibitors must fill out and turn in the weight card at check-in with a called/declared weight. This will become the animal's official weight. All market animals will be divided into classes according to weight after check-in. Exhibitors can pick up weigh cards at the Livestock Office, or cards will be present at check-in. The top three (or more, at the Show's discretion) placing animals in each class for market lamb, goat, and hog classes will be weighed immediately after class placings are announced. No reweighs will be allowed once the animal has stepped off the scale. A variance of 5 percent from the weight declared will be allowed. All animals outside of the 5percent tolerance will be disqualified.
