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PUREBRED DIVISION BARROW/GILT RULES

- All purebred hogs must have registration papers that match the exhibitor's name.
- All hogs must be ear-notched according to the Universal Notch System. No scabby or fresh ear notching will be accepted.
- Division 1 Purebred Market Swine
NEW: Barrows and gilts in the Purebred Market Swine Show will all show together.
- Division 2 Crossbred Market Swine
Class 1 Crossbred Barrows
Class 2 Crossbred Gilts
- Champion Crossbred and Champion Purebred will show against each other for Champion overall, Reserve Champion overall and the next eight (8) places in overall will be selected. The top 10 overall will sell Friday, Jan. 26, 2018 at the Sale of Champions at the Best Western Ramkota PLUS Exhibit Hall in Sioux Falls. All Sale of Champions animals will be terminated.
- Cash payouts are as follows:

2018 MARKET SWINE SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

- Entries made in this department shall be subject to and each exhibitor agrees to abide by the following: Sioux Empire Farm Show personnel reserve the right to adjust Rules and Regulations as seen fit.
- **Entry weight for live hogs will be 230 pounds up to 300 pounds. Entries under 230 pounds and over 300 pounds will be disqualified.**
- Open to anyone. Market hogs consigned must be the property of the consignor for at least 60 days prior to the show.
- Mailed entry fee is \$25/head; entries must be post-marked by Jan. 5, 2018. Online entry fee is \$20/head; online entries will be accepted through Jan. 12, 2018. Mailed entries submitted after Jan. 5, 2018 are \$50/head. No entry fee refunds.
- A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) is required on all animals entering the Sioux Empire Farm Show. Individual ID must be on the CVI and the herd premise ID number. **Swine from out of state need a PERMIT to enter South Dakota and the Sioux Empire Farm Show.** If unsure of health requirements for swine entering South Dakota, please have your veterinarian call the South Dakota State Veterinary Office at (605) 773-3321 and ask for the **PERMIT NUMBER** to enter on the CVI. **Before unloading,** CVI(s) must be shown to livestock attendant. Individual ID must match ID on health papers.
- Deadline for arrival is 6 p.m. on Tuesday, Jan. 23, 2018.
- Weigh-in is from 2-6 p.m. on Tuesday, Jan. 23, 2018. COOL forms must be completed and signed at check-in. Pigs will be identified by ear tag during check-in. Health certificate will be collected at check-in. The Sioux Empire Farm Show Swine Committee reserves the right to pull a pig at any time and re-weigh. **See "NEW TO SEFS" verbiage for weigh back system being implemented in 2018.**
- Crossbred market barrows and gilts show in separate classes based on weight. Barrows and gilts in the Purebred Market Swine Show will all show together.
- Barrow judging is at 8 a.m. on Wednesday, Jan. 24, 2018, with gilts immediately following.
- The top 10 Market Swine appearing in the Sale of Champions will be terminated.
- Cash awards will be mailed to winners within 30 days of the conclusion of the Sioux Empire Farm Show. The top placers will receive \$1,500 prorated, plus trophies.
- Five dollars (\$5) of the entry fee will be prorated in the form of premiums. The top five (5) pigs in each weight division will receive cash awards according to placements: 1st: 30 percent; 2nd: 25 percent; 3rd: 20 percent; 4th: 15 percent and 5th: 10 percent.
- **SALE OF CHAMPIONS:** The overall Grand and Reserve Champion and the next eight (8) places in the overall judging will sell Friday, Jan. 26, 2018, at the Mayor's Round-Up and Sale of Champions at the Best Western PLUS Ramkota Exhibit Hall in Sioux Falls. All Sale of Champions animals will be terminated. All market animals held for the Sale of Champions **MUST** be stalled in a designated area in the Expo Building until transport to the Sale of Champions. The Sale of Champions is a terminal sale. **Premium checks for those animals held for the Sale of Champions will be mailed within 30 days. Animals must be present at the sale in order to receive your check.**
- A Jackpot Showmanship Contest will be held. Juniors must be 21 years of age or under the day of the show. Entry fee is \$5 with two age divisions: 14 and under and 15 and up. The winner of each division will receive a prize. The money will be split 50/50 between the two division winners.
- Exhibitors selling hogs must mark with chalk themselves to clearly identify hogs to sell.
- No unethical oral or injected altering material will be allowed on any animal at the Sioux Empire Farm Show. The Farm Show retains the right to sample/test if needed.
- **NEW TO SEFS:** This year the Sioux Empire Farm Show will be using a weigh back system for the Market Swine Show, Market Lamb Show, and Market Goat Show. All hogs, goats, and lambs will show under a declared weight through submission of a weight card. Exhibitors are responsible for weighing their own animals, whether at home or on the check scale at the Show and then declaring that weight on the cards. Exhibitors must fill out and turn in the weight card at check-in with a called/declared weight. This will become the animal's official weight. All market animals will be divided into classes according to weight after check-in. Exhibitors can pick up weigh cards at the Livestock Office, or cards will be present at check-in. The top three (or more, at the Show's discretion) placing animals in each class for market lamb, goat, and hog classes will be weighed immediately after class placings are announced. No reweighs will be allowed once the animal has stepped off the scale. A variance of 5 percent from the weight declared will be allowed. All animals outside of the 5 percent tolerance will be disqualified.
